Foster Agreement

This Foster Agreement (“Agreement”) is hereby made and entered into between Saving Grace Animals For Adoption, Inc. (“Saving Grace”) and _____ (“Foster”).

The foster home program is an integral part of the work that Saving Grace does whereby more dogs can be helped and the foster dogs can have the opportunity to live in a home prior to adoption.

In consideration of the mutual promises contained herein, Saving Grace and Adopter agree to the following terms. All foster dogs must be approved for foster care before they can be taken from Saving Grace and remain owned solely by Saving Grace until such time as an adoption is approved and finalized.

The Foster is responsible for the foster dog while he/she is in the Foster’s care. The Foster home agrees to provide a safe temporary home for the foster dog while the dog is in his/her care and to abide by all local laws/regulations regarding said dog.

Dogs fostered for Saving Grace shall only be treated by a vet that works with Saving Grace. Transportation of the foster dog to and from Saving Grace for veterinary appointments and treatment shall be the responsibility of the Foster. Saving Grace is not responsible for any medical bills acquired for a foster dog unless both the veterinarian and the specific treatment are approved in writing through Saving Grace prior to any treatment commencing.

Most dogs at Saving Grace have come from an animal shelter where they have been exposed to a variety of diseases. Saving Grace is not responsible for the health of the Foster’s personal animals. The Foster agrees to use appropriate caution and accepts the risk of exposing his/her personal animals to animals from Saving Grace.

Saving Grace is not responsible for damage done to personal property or injury caused by a foster dog while in the care of the Foster. Being in a new home can be stressful for a dog and the Foster agrees to exercise caution and appropriate judgment in allowing other persons and/or animals to interact with the foster dog.

The Foster is responsible for meeting with potential adopters OR returning the animal to Saving Grace so he/she will be available during adoption hours if someone is interested in adopting. In addition, if the Foster wishes to adopt the foster dog or knows someone else interested, the Foster is encouraged to notify Saving Grace and complete an adoption application. Once another adopter has requested to

meet the foster dog, that person will have precedence in adoption of that animal if they are determined to be an appropriate home.

The Foster is responsible for bringing the foster dog to Saving Grace for necessary medical care such as vaccines, heartworm prevention and frontline. In the event you no longer wish to comply with the terms of this Agreement, you shall return the dog to Saving Grace.

Saving Grace only adopts out safe animals. If an animal bites or shows any aggression it must be returned to Saving Grace and will no longer be a candidate for adoption. Applications must be approved by Saving Grace before an animal can leave the Foster home or Saving Grace.

The foster dog shall be kept solely at the home of the Foster and shall not be transferred to another person or kept at another location without written consent from Saving Grace.
